

Camporall Check-In & Registration Details:

At Checkin

- 1) Only one vehicle (car, van, truck) can enter the camping area from each unit. There is one parking pass in each unit packet that was mailed out and this is to be put in the window of the vehicle that brings the camping supplies for the unit. (As you drive down the main road stay in the far right lane so you can turn right into the main fairgrounds).
- 2) All other vehicles arriving will need to stay in the far left lane and you will be directed to the parking lot to the left of the main road (this is where the registration tent will be and the truck will be parked that will be accepting your food donations).
- 3) Please send only one or two unit leaders (depending on size of unit) to the registration tent. Here you will be given your registration materials, wrist bands, t-shirts, patches and passport. All materials will be in boxes so they will be easy to carry.
- 4) Once everyone has their wrist bands, proceed to the tunnel that is the entrance to the fairgrounds. Follow the pathway straight back to the camping area.

On Saturday

There are a couple key ideas:

1. Spread out -- there's lots to see and do, but if everyone heads to the climbing area after the opening (just outside the grandstand), the climbing staff will be overwhelmed and the rocket and shooting sports staff will feel neglected. We would like each district to start in a designated area of the camp so that we at least begin the day with a good dispersal. Look for information about this in your registration materials and on this site later in the month.
2. Wristbands and passports. Everyone who registers for the event will get a wristband. This is your ticket in and out of the fairgrounds for the weekend and is needed for admission to some of the activities. There will also be a *passport*. Some activities are one time only, when you've had your turn, we'll mark your passport to make sure that other scouts can have a turn. Other activities are required to earn segments for the event patch -- the event patch is square and you can earn a patch that goes around it. We mark the passport as you earn the segments.
3. If you need help, remember there will be over 6000 people present whose slogan is "*Do a good turn*". You'll probably make their day. For challenging stuff, we have event staff available -- particularly in the admin building, several deputy sheriffs from Ross County, and a first aid station staffed by EMT's.
